Bailey of the third part. Whereas the said John Crompton on the first day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and thirty two in order to secure the payment of the bond of One thousand and two dollars and thirty cents to the said Phineas M. Bailey did by Indenture of trust of that date convey to the said Benjamin L. Draw his heirs Executors &c. The following land to wit all that tract or parcel of Land whereon the said John Crompton then lived or resided lying and being in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia containing Section more or less the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit on the East and North by the lands of John M. Noble and the West by Sacoche Swamp and on the North by the proctors all his right title claim or interest in the tract or parcel of Land whereon Sally Noble and that same land and held as her dower as the widow of John M. Noble and lying in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia containing more or less the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit on the North and East by the lands at that time belonging to the heirs of John S. Packer and on the South by the proctors Road and on the West by George's branch upon trust for the use and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned. and whereas before the executing and delivery of the said deed of trust the said John Crompton had fully satisfied and paid to the said Phineas M. Bailey the several sums of Money thereby secured which the said Phineas M. Bailey doth hereby acknowledge. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for the consideration of and as well as for the further consideration of One dollar in hand paid by the said John Crompton to the said Benjamin L. Draw at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Benjamin L. Draw with the assent and approbation of the said Phineas M. Bailey signified by his being party to these presents, and the said Phineas M. Bailey have granted bargained and sold remised released and confirmed unto the said John Crompton all the Estate right title interest claim and demand both at
