 the said Benjamin Williamson his heirs and assigns forever One Certain tract of Land lying in South-

 or the same more or less and bounded on the South by the lands of the said Benjamin Williamson
 and Thomas T. Turner on the West by Thomas T. Turner and the North by the land of Edwin B. Glend
 and on the East by the land of John Boy, To have and to hold the aforesaid tract of Land together
 with all thereto belonging to the said Benjamin Williamson his heirs & assigns forever and that the
 said Thomas T. Turner and Rebecca A. his wife do hereby warrant and forever defend all rights
