or assigns One Certain tract of Land and premises containing One hundred very more

Beale by the lands of Joseph Pope by the lands of Robert Dickes and by the lands of James
Beale. To have and to hold together with all the reversion whatsoever belonging thereto or
in any way or any wise whatsoever or appertaining thereto unto the said John Davis

or assigns with warrant Convey only such title as is in vested in him by the deed
