her heirs Executors and assigns with Privy Consent and agree to and with the said
Patience Wick her heirs Executors and assigns that she will by these presents
warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the above said tract or parcel
of Land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the Claim or demands
of all and every person or persons whatsoever. For Money whereof the said Christiana
