Deed made and entered into this 30th day of March 1842 between John A. Duran of the first part William Burnside of the second part and H. T. Smith of the third part. Whereas the said John A. Duran is indebted to the said H. T. Smith in the sum of twenty eight dollars due by him bearing date with these presents and whereas also the said H. T. Smith hath become bound as security for the said John A. Duran on bearing date to wit one in favour Anthony M. Howell for one hundred and thirty dollars bearing date with these presents one in favour of Joseph F. Lawrence for one hundred and twenty four dollars bearing date the 1st day of April 1842 one in favour of John W. Burnside for about twenty four dollars the date and amount not exactly recollectable one in favour of George Hall if for about fifty dollars the date and amount not exactly recollectable and also in all other case in which the said Smith is now bound and whereas also the said Smith is to become the said John A. Duran security for the sum of three guineas in North Carolina one in favour of George Hall one in favour of John W. Burnside one in favour of John W. Burnside and one in favour of John G. King about one hundred and twenty dollars the amount not exactly recollectable and whereas the said John A. Duran is willing and desirous the payment of the said sum of money to the said Smith to secure and is willing to save the said H. T. Smith Burnside and free from loss or damage by
