acknowledged by the said Martha E. Hurdner having fully satisfied and paid by the said Robert V. Wick
granted bargain and sold unto the said Robert V. Wick One Certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by Survey sixty five acres be the same
more or less and bounded as follows to wit. on the East by the lands of Robert V. Wick on the
South by the lands of Robert V. Wick and James Bell former tract of Land and on the west
by Robert V. Wick's tract that formerly belong to Joseph B. Wick and the North by the said
