Edwards his heirs and assigns the following property to wit a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation two hundred and thirtieth more or less being the same wherein the said Holloman now resides together with the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging to have and to hold to him the said Lilliton R. Edwards his heirs and assigns forever: And the said Micajah Holloman for himself his heirs Executors and administrators does covenant with the said Lilliton R. Edwards his heirs Executors and administrators and assigns that he the said Micajah Holloman will and his heirs Executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same unto the said Lilliton R. Edwards his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever. And the said Lilliton R.
