This Indenture made and entered into this day of May in the year of our Lord One
Thousand Eight hundred and forty two between Harrison P Pope of the County of Southampton of
State of Virginia of the one part and Miss Morrell of the same County and State of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Harrison P Pope for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred
dollars to him in hand paid by the said Miss Morrell at or before the making and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both granted bargain sold and
conferred and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm unto him the said
Miss Morrell his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land known by the
name of the former plantation Situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton
Containing fifty acres be the same more or less adjoining the lands of Elihu Pope and
Sarah Pope together with all the right title interest claim or demand of in and to the above
described tract or parcel of Land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
wise appertaining. It have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises
with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Miss Morrell
his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said
Miss Morrell his heirs and assigns forever and the said Harrison P Pope for himself his
heirs executors and assigns with hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said
Miss Morrell his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns that he will by these pre-
sents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of
Land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of
all and every person or persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof the said Harrison P Pope

This Indenture made this 7th day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight
hundred and forty two between Joseph D M Delle of the first part James E Clayton of
the second part and Martha Cogger of the third part. Whereas the said Joseph Delle
is justly indebted unto the said Martha Cogger in the sum of nine hundred and ninety
four dollars and forty six Cents as by bond bearing date on the 6th day of May in the
year 1842 more fully appearing which debt with the legal interest thereon accruing the said
Joseph D M Delle is willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture Witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration
of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Joseph D M Delle in hand paid
by the said James E Clayton at and before the making and delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Joseph Delle both granted bargain
sold and sold aliened conveyed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give
grant bargain sell alien convey release and confirm to the said James E Clayton his heirs
and assigns forever the following slaves and other property to wit namely Emily Louisa
Robert Martha Delle and the increase of the former two horses two carts and wheels
four beds and furniture one walnut table one mahogany sideboard two walnut
