 to Phillips and Reuben Phillips of the one part and Henry Kinard of the other part all of the County
 of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witness that the said David Williamson William
 D Phillips and Reuben Phillips for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars
 to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold
 aliened and confirmed and do by these presents grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto
 the said Henry Kinard his heirs and assigns forever One Certain Piece or parcel of Land
 lying and being in the County aforesaid more bounded as follows beginning at a post and
 corner near a corner now for Alexander Myricks line William Hill etc. line then
 along said Myricks line S 89° 12' 27" E to the Mohoning River a corner for said
 Myricks then up said River to the old River forked Morris Corners then along his line
 to Mills books line then along said books line to John Cosby Estate line then along
 said Cosby line to John Burdette line then his line to said William Hill etc. line then
 said Hill line to the first station and being the lot of Land which was devised to David
 Williamson aforesaid in the division of lands belonging to the Estate of Richard Williamson
 The father of the aforesaid David Williamson and Reuben Phillips The boundary and
 fully appear having reference to the Report of Commissioners appointed to divide the same
 containing by Estimation four hundred ninety five and a half acres more or less
 including the life right of the widow of Richard Williamson etc. apart from
 of the said tract or lot of Lands and all interest which we David Williamson William
 D Phillips and Reuben Phillips hold or may hereafter hold in the above tract of
 lands aforesaid. To have and to hold all and singular the said granted lands and
 premises above mentioned unto the said Henry Kinard his heirs and assigns forever
 and the said David Williamson William D Phillips and Reuben Phillips for
 themselves their heirs &c. doth further and agree to and with the said Henry Kinard
 his heirs &c. that they will forever warrant and defend the right title and all interest
 of the said premises before mentioned of the said lands unto him the said Henry Kinard
 his heirs and assigns forever against the claims and demands of them the said
 David Williamson William D Phillips and Reuben Phillips they heirs &c. assigns
 forever or any other person or persons whatsoever claiming the aforesaid lands
