Witness that the said Matthew W. Vaughan hath this day exposed to sale at public auction according to the Commission of the said Court of Trust the first of Land named in the said deed of Trust and the said Anthony Vaughan became the purchaser for the sum of One hundred and fifty two dollars and thirty seven and a half Cents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged To have and to hold the aforesaid Trust and parcel of Land containing Sixty two and a half Acres forever free from all the Claim or Claims demand or demands of the said Matthew W. Vaughan Trustee his heirs or assigns the said Matthew W. Vaughan with his heirs and assigns forever defend the aforesaid premises unto the said Anthony Vaughan his heirs and assigns as Trustee and no more. And Testimony whereof the said Matthew W. This Indenture made this fifth day of June in the year of Christ One thousand eight hundred and forty two between Bonnell & Briggs of the first part Lillian B. Edwards of the second part and Edward Bates and John Vick of the third part. Where The said Bates and Vick stand bound as Security for the said Bonnell & Briggs in a certain money bond made payable to James Vick in the penalty of \$525. 25 Cents to be discharged by the payment of two hundred and sixty two dollars and 74 Cents with interest from the day of February 1842 till paid in which forthcoming bond judgment was rendered at the last Term of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for Southampton County on which judgment and execution has issued and is now in the hands of the Sheriff of the said County. And whereas the said Bonnell & Briggs is willing and desirous to give and hath agreed to secure indemnity and save harmless the said Bates and Vick from all and every loss or damage whatever which they may sustain in consequence of said Security by conveying the property herein after mentioned unto the said Lillian B. Edwards whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold confirmed assigned and made over unto the said Lillian B. Edwards by these presents bargain and sell confirm assign and make over unto the said Lillian B. Edwards his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever One Certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and containing One hundred and twenty five acres more or less of being the tract of Land wherein the said Bonnell & Briggs resides. And the crops of corn, wheat, cotton, peas and potatoes now growing or which may be cultivated on the said tract of Land this present year. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land
