At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 1832  
 This deed of Bargain and sale from Abiram Blund and wife to Lewis Supre was  
 produced in Court and the subscribing witnesses thereto being John Gillies  
 Gillies Blund and Samuel Drury were sworn and examined the said Lewis  
 deposed that he was acquainted with the transcribers of Gillies Williamson William  
 Lanius Flood Williamson and Arthur Williamson and verily believe that their names subjoined  
 to the said deed were in their own hand writing, the said Gillies Blund and Samuel Drury  
 deposed that they were acquainted with the hand writing of Arthur Williamson and Gillies Williamson  
 two of the witnesses and believed that their names subscribed to the said deed to be in the  
 proper hand writing. Whereupon the said deed together with the Certificate annexed to  
 the prior examination and acknowledgment of the wife is ordered to be Recorded.

This Indenture made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year 1832 between Gilbert & Dick  
 & Debelle in consideration of trust made by Christopher Drury in favour of John Dick and  
 Amos G Drury of the first part and Nicholas & Debelle of the second part all of the County of  
 Southampton. Whereas the said Gilbert Dick trustee having made out of the lands incident  
 in and bounded by the aforesaid deed of trust according to the terms and provisions of the  
 said deed, and the above named Nicholas & Debelle of the second part having become the  
 purchasers. Now the Indenture witnesseth that the said Gilbert & Dick trustee doth and  
 in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Eleven dollars lawful money of  
 Virginia to him paid by the said Nicholas & Debelle the receipt whereof he the said  
 Dick doth hereby acknowledge both given payment bargained and sold and as of the  
 grants given grant bargain and sell unto the said Nicholas & Debelle a certain tract  
 or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton containing by survey One  
 hundred and Eleven acres more or less and bounded as follows to wit on the east  
 by the land of John Drury both on the west by the land of John Drury and in the back  
 by the lands belonging to the lands belonging to the orphan children of Joseph Drury  
 and the north by the land of Christopher Drury being the same tract or parcel of land described
