This Indenture made this fourth day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty two between Nevil Drew and Lucy his wife of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and James Drury of the said County and state of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars in bonds paid by the said James Drury the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Nevil Drew and Lucy his wife have granted bargained sold aliened enfranchised and confirmed unto the said James Drury all their right title and interest in a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing four hundred acres more or less and bounded as follows (viz) on the East by the lands of Humphrey Drury North by the lands of said James Drury John Drury and the heirs of Job Morris West by the lands of Timon J Westbrook and South by the lands of Job Toland and to appear more fully it being the land a part of which the said Drew purchased of Charles Harrison a part of his father James Drew estate and a part of which his father-in-law David Westbrook bequeathed him and a part of which he beared from his brother-in-law David Westbrook the right title understanded of which tract of Land the said Nevil Drew and Lucy his wife do for themselves their heirs and assigns warrant and forever defend the right and title of the said Land unto the said James Drury his heirs and assigns against the claim of any person or persons whatsoever. And witness wherefore the said Nevil Drew and Lucy his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year as first above written -
