

This Indenture made the 9th day of June in the year of our Lord 1842 between James
 Stephenson of the first part and John M. Hurley of the second part and Nathaniel B. Bryant
 of the third part. Whereas the said Jeremiah Stephenson is justly indebted to the said Nathaniel
 B. Bryant in the sum of One hundred and thirty seven dollars and thirty Cents by bond
 payable with interest from the 1st day of January 1842 in the sum of One hundred and ten
 dollars 63^{cts} payable on the 2nd day of December next (by bond) and the further sum of eleven
 Dimes and ninety five dollars as by bond executed to Henry M. Mussey trustee of said bond
 in the year 1841 which bond will become due sometime this present year 1842 which said bond
 fully appears by reference to said bond which with the legal interest thereon according
 the said Jeremiah Stephenson is willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture
 Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration
 of One dollar of lawful money to the said Jeremiah Stephenson in hand paid by the
 said John M. Hurley at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Jeremiah Stephenson both given granted assigned
 and sold and by these presents with good bargain and sold to the said John M. Hurley his
 heirs and assigns forever the following personal property to wit all his interest in the growing
 crop of Corn fodder peas potatoes and beans which may be made in the ground of Nathaniel
 B. Bryant which he the said Stephenson now cultivating or sharing also one acre one lot
 and four rods which one quarter be and furniture One Metal Clock One shot gun
 gunning stonely Crookware Kitchens forks Chairs Table Kitchen furniture of every
 description Stock of hogs and their future increase. To have and to hold the said John
 granted or intended to be granted property to the said John M. Hurley his heirs and assigns
 forever. And the said Jeremiah Stephenson for himself his heirs Executors and administrators
 do hereby warrant and defend the right and title in and to the aforesaid property against
 Claims or Claims of all and every person or persons claiming by or through him and the
 aforesaid John M. Hurley his heirs Executors administrators or assigns forever upon trust
 reverently the said John M. Hurley his heirs Executors &c shall permit the said Jeremiah
 Stephenson to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the aforesaid property until
 conveyed until default be made in the payment of the said Sum of Money either in
 whole or in part or the Debt to which the said Bryant is bound as security thereupon the
 juster East that the said John M. Hurley his heirs Executors or administrators do and
 after the happening of such default of payment as he may think proper or at the request
 of the said Nathaniel B. Bryant his heirs Executors or assigns shall request him to the highest
 bidder at public auction so much thereof as the said Nathaniel may deem necessary to satisfy
 the aforesaid debt interest and Costs attending these premises after having paid the
 time and place of such sale at his own discretion and giving at least twenty day
 Notice thereof at three or more public places within the County first day and notice of
 the cost of carrying these presents into effect then satisfy the above specified debt and interest and
 may have or receive thereon and if any surplus remain pay to the aforesaid Jeremiah Stephenson
 or order. But if the whole of the aforesaid Sum of Money above mentioned shall be fully paid off
 and discharged to the satisfaction of the aforesaid Nathaniel B. Bryant his Executors assigns
 or assigns so that no default be made of the payment then this Indenture to be void and of no
 remain to remain in full force and Virtue. In Witness whereof the parties to these presents
