This deed of bargain and sale from Littleton R. Edwards and Anthony M. Williams and Caroline  
& his wife to George A. W. Munro was acknowledged by the said Edwards one of the parties thereto  
and together with the Certificate of the acknowledgement of the said Williams and proving execution  
of his wife annexed to Record -

This Indenture made this 27<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord 1842 between William D.  
Murd of the first part Nathan R. Bryant of the second part and Joseph T. Liles of the third part and  
Lies make all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said William D. Murd is justly indebted  
to the said Joseph T. Liles in the sum of Twenty Eight dollars and six Cents by bond payable with interest  
thereon from the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1832 which will more fully appear by reference to said bond which  
duly and with legal interest thereon according the said William D. Murd is willing and desirous to become -  
Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the premises and also for the further  
consideration of One dollar of lawful Money to the said Nathan R. Bryant at and before the sealing  
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said William D. Murd  
both given granted bargained and sold and by these presents both given bargain and sell to the said  
N. R. Bryant his heirs and assigns forever the following personal property to wit all of his growing crop  
of Corn and fodder two feather beds and furniture six Dining Chairs two Chests for Table together  
with household and kitchen furniture One grey mare and her foal. To have and to hold the  
said hereby granted or intended to be granted property to the said N. R. Bryant his heirs and  
assigns forever. and the said William D. Murd for himself his heirs Executors and administrators  
with hereby warrant and defend the right and title in and to the aforesaid property against the  
Claims or Claims of all and every person or persons claiming by or through him unto the aforesaid  
N. R. Bryant his heirs Executors and administrators and assignee forever upon trust notwithstanding  
the said N. R. Bryant his heirs Executors &c shall permit the said William D. Murd to remain in  
quiet and peaceful possession of the aforesaid property hereby Conveyed until default be made in  
the payment of the said sum of Money either in the whole or part or the debt to which is due  
to the said Joseph T. Liles then upon this further trust that the said N. R. Bryant his heirs Executors and  
administrators so soon after the happening of such default of payment may think proper or at the  
request of the said Joseph T. Liles his heirs Executors or assigns shall require sell to the highest bidder  
at public auction as much thereof as the trustee may deem necessary to satisfy the aforesaid debt  
principal and costs attending these premises after having fixed the time and place of sale at his own  
discretion and giving at least Twenty days notice thereof at three or more public places within the  
County first pay and satisfy the costs of carrying these premises into effect then satisfy the above  
specified debt and interest which may have accrued thereon and if any surplus remain paid  
to the aforesaid William D. Murd or over but if the whole of the debt above mentioned shall be fully  
paid off and discharged to the satisfaction of the aforesaid Joseph T. Liles his Executors administrators  
or assigns so that no default be made of the payment then this Indenture to be void or else to  
remain in full force and virtue. And witness whereof the parties to these presents
