This Indenture made and executed this first day of March 1842 One thousand Eight hundred
and forty two between John Moore junr. and Letitia his wife of the first part and George W. Harner
of the second part all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witness that the said
John Moore junr. and Letitia his wife have for and in Consideration of the sum of Eight
hundred and eighty six dollars and seven Cents to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell except and
Consign unto the said George W. Harner his heirs and assigns forever One Certain tract and
parcel of Land containing by Survey One hundred and thirty three acres two rods lying and
being in Southampton County near Murfrees Cross roads and is bounded as follows (viz)
Beginning at a pine at the Jerusalem Corner of the tract and Mills Murfee Thence N 30° E
1130 ft 7 links along the said Road to a hickory a corner of this tract and James D
Maysburg Thence N 32° E 1150 to a small pine corner of this tract Thence S 46° E 240 ft 10 links
to another small pine Thence S 15° E 22 ft to a pine Thence S 52° 14 ft to an oak Thence
S 41° E 29 ft to the Centre of the Black water road a large Bush top pine standing near
Thence N 5° E 62 ft along said road to the Corner of the old field Thence S 62° E 60 ft to
a pine Thence S 68° E 19 ft to a white gum Thence S 62° E 16 ft to a pine corner of James D
Maysburg and John Moore junr. in the line of this tract Thence S 62° E 58 ft along a new
line of marked trees to a white oak a new corner of this tract and the said John Moore junr.
Thence S 26° W 116 ft along a new line of marked trees to a large pine Thence S 10° W 25 ft
along a new line of marked trees to a small red oak a corner of John Moore junr. and
William W. Edwards Thence S 7° W 140 ft along the old line of marked trees between this
tract and William W. Edwards to a pine Thence S 5° W 112 ft to a pine Thence S 26° W 6 ft
pine corner of this tract Thence West 28 ft to a Maypole corner of William W. Edwards and
Mills Murfee Thence N 25° W 112 ft to a pine Thence N 29° W 30 ft to a pine Thence N 34°
18 ft to a pine Thence S 67° 46 ft to a sweet gum Thence S 71° W 112 ft to a pine and
red oak bush side line at the Black Water Road Thence S 83° W 138 ft 10 links along a line
of marked trees to the beginning - ED Have and to hold the aforesaid tract and parcel
of Land forever free from the claim or claims demand or demands of all and every
person whomsoever - It includes the tracts and parcels of Land the said John Moore
purchased of Thomas C. Jones of the D. Maysburg and Minny Thence and a half acre
of the tract purchased by the said John Moore of the Randolph Edwards tract
The said John Moore junr. and Letitia his wife do hereby warrant and will forever
defend the aforesaid premises with every part and parcel thereof and herents belonging
with all the reversion and reversioning revenues and remainings yearly and other rents unto the
said George W. Harner his heirs and assigns forever free from all the claims or claims demand or
demands of all and every person whomsoever. For Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands
