This Indenture made this 13th day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty two between Robert R Collier Commissioner appointed by the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for the Town of Petersburg of the first part and John A Person of the County of Southampton of the other parts Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty one dollars 13 cents by the said Person to the said Collier Commissioner &c in hand paid in full of the bond directed by said Court to be collected by said Collier and Delany and in obedience to a decree made by said Court in June 1842 the receipt of which sum of Money in full of the balance of the purchase money for the land hereinafter conveyed is hereby acknowledged and which said money fully applied by the record and proceedings in the Chancery suit depending in said Court in favour of Joseph Bragg and other plaintiffs and John New Adversus Defendants the said Robert R Collier Commissioner &c as aforesaid hath bargained and sold granted assigned transferred and made over unto the said John A Person a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton in the Mathews River bounded by the name of "Dorchester" and containing five hundred acres be the same more or less To have the same land conveyed by and from James Lee and wife to James Lee Bragg of Jones and Mordecai of Osborne dated March 12th 1833 and duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton together with all and singular the advantages and appurtenances of every kind thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances unto the said Person his heirs and assigns forever to and for his and their only proper use and behoof For Testimony whereof the said Robert R Collier Commissioner &c as aforesaid hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the date first above written -
