

This Indenture made and entered into this 6th day of August 1842 between Lemuel P. Nicholson
 and Mary & his wife of the first part and William G. Bowditch of the second part and William
 Spark & Trustee A Spark and Littler & Edwards of the third part all of the County of Southampton. Whereas
 Exam? The said Lemuel P. Nicholson is justly indebted unto the said William A. Spark in the sum
 of £445 or thereabouts and by bond executed sometime in the year 1841 and wherous the said
 Spark is bound as security for the said Nicholson that is to say in a bond executed to
 Alfred P. Bowley esq: for the sum of four thousand dollars executed in 1841 the same
 to Bragg and Thomas of Finsbury for two hundred and forty six dollars and three
 22nd February 1842 also one to John M. Barley for three hundred and thirty dollars or there
 abouts executed in the latter part of 1841 or early in the year 1842 and wherous the said
 Littler & Edwards is bound as security for the said Nicholson in two forthcoming on
 delivery bonds taken upon execution paid out of the Clerks office of the Circuit Superior
 Court of Law and Chancery for Southampton County one in favour of Bragg for £60
 and the other in favour of Bragg and Thomas the amounts and dates of which, are not
 recollectec - And wherous the said Lemuel P. Nicholson is willing and anxious to secure
 and agrees to secure the payment of the sum of money aforesaid and the said Spark
 also to indemnify and save harmless the said Spark and Edwards from sustaining any
 loss or damage whatever in Consequence of their being his the said Nicholsons security in
 the several cases herein before mentioned by conveying unto the said William G. Bowditch
 the property herein after mentioned in trust. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth
 That the said Lemuel P. Nicholson and Mary & his wife for and in consideration of the sum
 aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Lemuel
 P. on hand paid by the said Mr. G. Bowditch the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell & confirm
 unto the said William G. Bowditch his heirs Executing administrators or assigns the following
 property to wit a certain lot situated in the Town of Foweyland in the County aforesaid
 and designated in the plat of said Town as No 13 being the same which the said
 Nicholson purchased of Mr. B. Bloodman together with the buildings and improvements
 appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining also the following
 slaves to wit Dick, Jenny, una Child, Orris, Glorie and Anthony household and
 Kitchen furniture farming Utensils stock of horses Cattle and Hogs crop of 1/2
 description Buggs and Harness zig una harness saddle and bridle and a number Books
 and the following accounts due against the Estate of James Ricketts for £800. one hundred
 Thomas Bowes for £80. One note against Mosey J. Whitney for £60 also sundry debts
 on the hands of. — To have and to hold the lot of land aforesaid and all the
 buildings and improvements theron and the appurtenances of every kind thereto belonging
 together with the aforesaid slaves and the future increase of the family thereof and
 the other property herein before Conveyed unto him the said William G. Bowditch his heirs
 executors and administrators and assigns forever. In trust and upon Condition
 nevertheless that the property aforesaid shall remain in the possession of the said Lemuel P.
 Nicholson and for him to receive the benefit thereof until the said Mr. G. Bowditch
 shall be deceased as herein after provided for to make sale thereof and upon the
 further trust that if the said Lemuel P. Nicholson shall duly pay to me discharge the said
 herein before mentioned and the said William A. Spark with all interest therein to all
