Pope at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto him the said Benj^e E. Pope his heirs and assigns forever One Certain Tract or parcel of Land (situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by a late survey eight acres and bounded by the lands of Benj^e E. Pope and Caswell Morrell together with all the right title Interest Claims or demands of in and to the above described tract or parcel of Land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with all its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Benj^e E. Pope his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Benj^e E. Pope his heirs and assigns forever, and the said John R. Rockelle for himself his heirs and assigns doth hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said Benj^e E. Pope his heirs and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the Claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever - On Witness whereof the said John R.
