Rockwell for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and ninety eight dollars and thirty Cents Current money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Curwell Morrell at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm unto him the said Curwell Morrell his heirs and assigns forever the Certain tract or parcel of land (situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by a late survey One hundred and fifty two acres (exclusive of two acres held by the trustees of Whitehouse Meeting House) be the same more or less being a part of the tract of land the said Mrs. L. & John R. Rockwell inherited from Edmund Day dec'd - and bounded by the lands of Benjⁿ & Pope Nuttall Morrell Day Day and others - together with all the right title interest (claim or demand of in and to the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with all its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Curwell Morrell his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mrs. L. and John R. Rockwell for themselves their heirs and assigns doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Curwell Morrell his heirs and assigns that they will by these presents executed and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever - And Witnesseth that the said Mrs. L. and John R. Rockwell hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first written
