Jones and Martha his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators with previous Covenant and agree to and with the said George A. W. Newson his heirs and assigns that they will by these presents forever warrant and defend the right and title to the said tract or parcel of land unto the said George A. W. Newson his heirs and assigns forever. For Testimony whereof the said Thomas L. Jones and Martha his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written -
