Drury This Indenture made this 15th day of August in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred
and forty two between Joseph Drury of the first part Mrs. R. Stephenson of the second part and
Stephenson and Alfred J. Stephenson of the third part - Whereas the said Joseph Drury is justly indebted to the said
Alfred J. Stephenson in the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars to be paid on the 20th day of
Septem^r? September in the year eighteen hundred and forty one and 15th August 1842 as by bond bearing
date on the 20th day of September in the year 1841 and 15th August 1842 more fully appearing
to the said Alfred J. Stephenson which debt with the legal interest thereon accruing the said Joseph Drury is willing and
desires to secure - Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the
promises and also for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful money of M^{ts} to the
said Joseph Drury in hand paid by the said Mrs. R. Stephenson at and before the executing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Joseph Drury
both given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and Conferred and by these
presents doth give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release and Conferred to the said Mrs. R.
Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever all my interest in the estate of Parmelia Clayton
being in the County of Southampton and state of Va with all and singular appurtenances
to the said interest and all the estate right title and interest of the said Joseph Drury in and
to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted interest. To have and to hold the said
herely granted or intended to be hereby granted interest in the estate of the said Parmelia
Clayton herely conveyed unto the said Mrs. R. Stephenson his heirs Exors admors and assigns
forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Mrs. R. Stephenson his heirs Exors
admors and assigns forever - And said the Joseph Drury for himself his heirs Exors
admors doth hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said William R.
Stephenson his heirs Exors and admors and assigns forever in manner and form
following that is to say that the said Joseph Drury his heirs Exors and admors the
aforesaid interest in the estate of the aforesaid Parmelia Clayton unto the said Mrs. R.
Stephenson his heirs Exors and admors and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall
and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. Upon trust nevertheless that
the said Mrs. R. Stephenson his heirs Exors and admors shall permit the said Joseph
Drury to take the profits of the said interest to his own use and to pay the same
in the payment of the said sum of one hundred and twenty dollars with interest in the whole
or in part. And then upon this further trust that - or any two of them or the survivor of
