 said Joseph B Butler Covenant and agrees with the other parties hereto that in case the
 said Miles Dick his heirs or assigns shall fail to make payment of the debt and interest
 aforesaid agreeable to the terms of the writing obligatory ^{thereon} that then the said Joseph B Butler
 his heirs or assigns shall at the request of the said Bennett R Whigfield his heirs or
 assigns at any after given legal notice of the time and place of such sale sell at public sale the
 property hereby conveyed or so much thereof as will be sufficient to discharge the debt and
 interest aforesaid or so much as may be then due together with the expenses arising from
 the notice and sale and all other reasonable and contingent charges having and charging
 the money arising from the sale to the said Bennett R Whigfield his heirs or assigns or
 assigns or so much as he may see and owing and after satisfying the debt and costs aforesaid
 shall pay the surplus money if any to the said Miles Dick his heirs or assigns

 Given? The Indenture made this 16th day of Decr in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and forty one between Horamur Murron of the first part and Alfred S Stephenson of
 the second part and Allen Stephenson of the third part. Whereas the said Horamur Murron is
 greatly indebted to the said Allen Stephenson on a bond of \$55.14 bearing date the 18th day of December
 1841 which the said Allen Stephenson holds against the said Horamur Murron which said bond
 fully appears by reference to the said bond which said the said Horamur Murron is willing and
 desirous to discharge. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the property
 and also for the further consideration of an advance of sundry money of Virginia to the said
 Horamur Murron in hand paid by the said A. S. Stephenson at and before the writing and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Horamur
 Murron hath given granted conveyed and aliened in full release and confirmed and by these
 presents with full good bargain and alien in full release and confirmed to the said A. S. Stephenson
 his heirs and assigns forever all the property belonging to the said Horamur Murron namely of
 1000 Acres more or less together with 6000 lbs of cotton 2 feather beds and furniture &c
