and forever defend by these presents upon true ownership that the said A. & S. Stephenson his heirs
Executors and assigns shall shall permit the said housemaid Marron to remain in quiet and
peaceable possession of the said property until default be made in the payment of the said
debt due to the said Allen Stephenson either in whole or in part and then upon this further trust
that his heirs Executors admirors or assigns shall and will do soon after the happening of such default of
payment as he or any or either of them or the survivors of them or the heirs Executors admirors or assigns
of such survivors may think proper or the said Allen Stephenson his heirs Executors admirors or assigns shall
request sell the said property or such part of the hereby granted property as the trustee or his representative
- the hereby authorized to act shall think sufficient for the purpose and shall think proper to sell to
the highest bidder for ready money at public auction after having fixed the time and place of
sale at their own discretion and given ten days notice thereof in one or more of the news-
