said Goodman Morris his heirs Executors and executors the aforesaid property unto the said Alfred J.  
Stephenson his heirs Executors and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant  
and forever defend by these presents upon trust nevertheless that the said A.J. Stephenson his heirs  
executors and assigns shall shall permit the said Goodman Morris to remain in quiet and  
peaceable possession of the said property until default be made in the payment of the said  
debt due to the said Allen Stephenson either in whole or in part and then upon this further trust  
that his heirs Executors, executors or assigns shall and will do and after the happening of such default of  
payment as he or any or either of them or the survivor of them or the heirs Executors executors or assigns  
of such survivor may think proper or the said Allen Stephenson his heirs Executors executors or assigns shall  
require sell the said property or such part of the hereby granted property as the trustee or his representative  
hereby authorized to act shall think sufficient for the purpose and shall think proper to sell  
the highest bidder for ready money at public auction after having fixed the time and place of  
sale at their own discretion and given two days notice thereof in one or more of the news-  
papers printed in the State of Virginia and also noticing the sum by advertisement to be  
put up at the door of the courthouse of Southampton County on some Court day previous to the  
day of sale and out of the money arising from such sale shall after satisfying the charges  
thereof and and all other expence attending the property pay to the said Allen Stephenson  
his heirs Executors executors or assigns the debt above referred to and the balance if any pay over to the said
