

Stephenson to Vezekunt
 bond? This Indenture made this 6th day of August in the year One thousand Eight hundred and
 forty two between Alfred T Stephenson of the one part (acting as trustee) and James B Vezekunt of the
 second part and both of the County of Southampton. Witness that for and in consideration of the
 sum of One hundred and twenty dollars Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid or come
 to be paid at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged by the said Alfred T Stephenson trustee has bargained and sold unto by these
 presents well bargained and well alien in fee simple and Confirm to the said James B Vezekunt the
 tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton belonging to David Branch and
 by him conveyed to me by deed of trust bearing date 17th August 1840 for purposes therein
 fully set forth and of record in the Clerk's Office of the County aforesaid and bounded as follows
 to wit East by Terrara Swamp North by the lands of William B Pond West by J. J. Carroll
 and South by the lands of Herbert Laidier jr the land belonging to the Estate of Benjamin
 Hancock and also by that of William C Bailey being the land formerly owned by David Branch
 containing One hundred and twenty acres and One half acre together with all and singular the
 premises and appurtenances of the same or thereto belonging the reversion and reversions yearly
 and other rents issues and profits and every part and parcel thereof. We have and to hold
 the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be
 bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said James B Vezekunt his
 heirs and assigns forever. And the said Alfred T Stephenson for himself this time as trustee the
 said tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto
 the said James B Vezekunt his heirs and assigns free from the Claim or Claims of him
 the said David Branch and his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever
 in fee shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. For Money whereof
 the said Alfred T Stephenson has become and his heirs and assigns his sole self as
 trustee the day and year first above written -

Nicholson to Bond? This Indenture made and entered into this 10th day of August 1842 between Lemuel
 P Nicholson Litten B Edwards of the second part and James F French and Solomon F
 French of the third part. Witness that whereas the said James F French and Solomon F
 French are securing for the said Lemuel P Nicholson the said James F French in a bond executed
 by Lemuel P Nicholson to James B Vezekunt for about One hundred and fourteen dollars
 date not recollected and the said French is owing to Spencer Cook for about fifty dollars
 (on open account for clothes purchased) and the said Solomon French is securing for the
 said Nicholson in the sum of about fifty dollars in a note executed to Robert Reese or
 Reese and Morrell (Cardina) date of bond or note not recollected and the said Nicholson
