 This Indenture made this 15th day of September AD 1842 between Collier Fugerson of
 the One part William Beale of the 2^d part and Richard Fugerson of the third part Witnesseth
 that the said Collier Fugerson for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid
 at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge
 that this day bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain sell assign and convey to the
 said Richard Fugerson trustee the following named property to wit One bay Mare Eighteen
 head of hogs two cows and all the balance of his household and kitchen furniture also his crop
 of Corn peas and garden. To have and to hold the above named articles of personal estate
 (to wit) One bay Mare Eighteen head of hogs two cows and all the balance of the household and
 kitchen furniture and crop of Corn peas and garden to him the said Richard Fugerson his
 heirs and assigns forever. And trust nevertheless and for the following purposes to wit.
 Whereas the said Collier Fugerson is justly indebted to the said William Beale by note bearing
 date the first day of June 1842 for the sum of Eighty two dollars and thirty five Cents. Now for
 the securing the payment of the aforesaid debt to the said William Beale or before the first
 day of November next should the said Collier Fugerson fail to pay or cause to be paid
 the debt before mentioned together with the interest accruing thereon then the said Richard
 Fugerson is hereby authorized empowered and directed at any time after the said day
 of Nov^r, upon the request of the said William Beale or his representatives to mortgage
 the said above named property or any part of it for the space of two days and sell at public
 sale the said property so advertised to the highest bidder for cash and the proceeds of
 the said sale to be applied to the payment of the said debt and interest aforesaid and should
 the proceeds of ———— sale more than pay the said debt and interest and the reasonable
 expenses of said trustee then the residue if any to be paid to the said Collier Fugerson
