Now this Indenture witnesseth that for the Consideration aforesaid as well as for the further Consideration of One dollar in hand paid by the said William McCutcher to the said Bennett & Whitfield as and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Bennett & Whitfield (with the assent and approbation of the said John Hargrave, Signified by his being party to these presents and the said John Hargrave have granted bargained and sold certain released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell remise release and forgive unto the said William McCutcher all the Estate right title interest Claims and demands both at law and in equity which the said Bennett & Whitfield and John Hargrave have or hold in the lands and plantation above mentioned. To have and to hold the said lands and plantation to the said William McCutcher his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever. To the only proper use and behoof of him the said William McCutcher his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever. And the said Bennett & Whitfield and John Hargrave for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators the above mentioned lands and plantation unto the said William McCutcher his heirs Executors administrators and assigns in as full and ample manner as the same was warranted by the said William McCutcher by deed of Trust above recited as warrant the same to the said William McCutcher against the Claim or Claims of them the said Bennett & Whitfield and John Hargrave and all persons Claiming by or under them.
