Current Money of Va with growing interest - Now therefore to secure the said sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars and for the further sum of One dollar to them the said Thomas Bewar and wife Elizabeth in hand paid by the said Thomas D Bewar junr. at and before the coming and delivery of this indenture the receipt is hereby acknowledged with grant bargain and sell by these presents good and lawful which is now planted and growing on the land and plantation of the said Elizabeth Page of the said Thomas Bewar agt. the said Crop of Corn if well tended is supposed to be good for seed and to be the same more or less to the said Thomas D Bewar junr upon trust monthly the said Thomas D Bewar junr may and shall at any time after the said Crop is made and ripe enough to house at the request of the said Milton & Bewar advertise and sell for cash after giving two days publication thereof the said Crop of Corn and fodder and out of the money arising therefrom first pay and satisfy all reasonable expensy advancing said sale and then the aforesaid debt and the overplus if any pay and return to the said Thomas Bewar senr and Elizabeth P his wife or their legal representatives - In Witness whereof the parties have hereunto set their hands and seals this first day of June 1820

Know all men by these presents that I Elizabeth P Bewar of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia have made ordained constituted and appointed and by these presents do make ordain constitute and appoint my husband Thomas Bewar my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name but to my use to ask demand sue for recover and receive all and every such debts and arrears of debt as are now due and will be due or owing to me by or from any person or persons whatsoever and for good payment of the same debt or arrears of debt or any part thereof to enter and distrain and the distress so taken to cause to be disposed of according to law, and upon payment of the said debt or arrears of debt or any part thereof for me and in my name to give acquittances and discharges for the same and the moneys so by him received immediately thereupon to pay over to me or my representatives or to my Orer and further to do execute all and every other lawful act and acts needful for recovering receiving and obtaining of said debt or arrears of said debt now due or to grow due for the premises or any part thereof but to my use in agreement as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if I were personally present hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in or about the premises; In Witness whereof I have unto set my hand and seal this 25th day of January Eighteen hundred and forty two -
