It is all men by these presents that we Littleton R Edwards, Edwards Butts Robert Ridley William J Sebell are held and firmly bound unto John M Gregory Esq Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia and his successors in the Office of Governor in the just and full sum of five thousand dollars to be paid unto the said acting Governor and his successors in the office Governor for the time being, to which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this 17<sup>th</sup> day of October 1842. The condition of this above obligation is such that if the above bound Littleton R Edwards who hath this day been appointed Clerk of the Court of Southampton County shall faithfully account for and pay into the public Treasury, in the manner prescribed by law, the Taxes on land proprie license and all other public monies which shall come into his hands during his continuance in Office, on attestations, protestations and other instruments of publication under his seal of Office, then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

This Inventory made this 18<sup>th</sup> day of January one thousand eight hundred & forty two between Martha E Breal of the first part James Maget of the second part and John Barrett and Henry Kinsland all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the third part Witnesseth that the said Martha E Breal in order to secure the payment of the following debts to us, one bond signed by said Martha E Breal payable to John Barrett for the sum of One hundred and sixteen dollars and seventy nine cents dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1842, one bond signed by said Martha E Breal payable to said Henry Kinsland for the sum of eighteen dollars and eighty seven cents dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1842 with interest from 1<sup>st</sup> January 1842 One other bond signed by said Martha E Breal with said John Barrett & Henry Kinsland security payable to Simon Phipps Guardian to James Barnes (orphan) for the sum of four hundred & seventeen dollars dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1842. And in consideration of the sum of one dollar to her given and paid by the said James Maget at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, she the said Martha E Breal hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said James Maget all her own interest in the tract of land wherein she now lies it being the same which was allotted to her out of the lands of her late husband Richard Williamson deceased and the yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and of
