This Indenture made and entered into this 16th day of Oct^r 1842 by and between Nathan Whitfield, Jonathan T. Griffin and Bonnett Barrett all of them of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia Whose full names and true names that he the said Nathan Whitfield in order to secure and indemnify the said Bonnett Barrett first a debt of seventeen dollars and sixty two cents due this the above day & date to him the said Barrett as will appear by bond of even date herewith also to indemnify him the said Barrett as security in the sum of twenty nine dollars and thirty six cents to Harrison R. Lefe also due this the above day and date & further to indemnify him the said Barrett in becoming security for him the said Whitfield to Jacob Barnes in the sum of twenty one dollars and eighty cents due this the above day and date each of which debts appear by bond executed by them the said Nathan Whitfield & Bonnett Barrett his security with their several interests which may hereafter accrue together with the costs of recording and carrying into effect these presents and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Nathan Whitfield in hand paid by the said J. T. Griffin at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Nathan Whitfield hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said J. T. Griffin the following named property to wit: one horse one bay mare one or one do one wagon & harness one pair cart wheels one bed & furniture one bedstead & one chest painted blue two spin wheels one staff one table, five barrels, four rush seat chairs, seven baskets, case knives & forks, seven plates, twelve spoons, one dish one pitcher, one counter three Jugs, two small kags, six bottles, one qt. pot, one water pail, four tubs, one meal sieve, one tray, one pot, one pan, one kettle, one spider, one potrack, one iron shovel, one pair steel yards, two axes, one iron wedge, three plows, each with plowhook & counter with the necessary plow harness, six plowhoses, three coulters, ten weed hoes, one grub hoe, one bridle, one saddle, four hats of hogs standing crop, of corn in the field, two stacks of fodder, two fowls, one bread stove, to have and to hold the above described property and every part & parcel thereof to him the said J. T. Griffin with all the right and title which he the said Nathan Whitfield has heretofore held in the same to him the said J. T. Griffin his heirs and assigns forever upon trust nevertheless that he the said J. T. Griffin at the request of either of the parties shall as soon as conveniently he can after such notice advertises the time & place of sale of the above described property at least ten days previous to such sale the terms thereof for each paid down and out of the monies raised therefrom first pay all reasonable costs and charges attending the full execution hereof and next satisfy the aforesaid debts in as much of them as the amount of sales will do & if a surplus money thereafter remain he the said Griffin shall pay over the same to him the said Nathan Whitfield or to his order in witness whereof the parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year first before written
