This Indenture made and entered into this 18<sup>th</sup> day of Oct 1842 by and between Nathan Whitfield, Jonathan J. Griffin and Bennett Barrett all of them of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Nathan Whitfield in order to secure and indemnify the said Bennett Barrett first a debt of seventeen dollars and forty two cents due the above day of date to him the said Barrett as will appear by bond of even date herewith also to indemnify him the said Barrett as security in the sum of twenty nine dollars and thirty six cents to Harrison P. Pepe also due this the above day and date & further to indemnify him the said Barrett in becoming security for him the said Whitfield to Jacob Barnes in the sum of twenty one dollars and eighty cents due this the above day and date each of which debts appear by bond executed by them the said Nathan Whitfield & Bennett Barrett his security with their several interests which may hereafter accrue together with the costs of recording and carrying into effect these presents and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Nathan Whitfield in hand paid by the said J. J. Griffin at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Nathan Whitfield hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said J. J. Griffin the following named property to wit: one small house, one bay mare or mare on a wagon of harness, one pair cart wheels, one bed of furniture, one bedding &c, one chest painted blue, two spin wheels, one buff, one table, five barrels, four rush seat chairs, seven baskets, case of nine forks, seven plates, twelve spoons, one dish, one pitcher, one decanter, three jugs, two small flags, six bottles, one of pot, one water pail, four tubs, one meal sieve, one tray, one pot, one pan, one kettle, one spider, one pot rack, one iron shovel, one pair steel yards, two axes, one iron wedge, three plows, each with plowshare & coulter with the necessary plow harrow, six plow hoes, three coulters, ten wood hoes, one grub hoe, one trill, one saddle, four head of hogs standing on top of corn, in the field, two stacks of fodder, two fowls, one bread iron, to have and to hold the above described property and every part & parcel thereof to him the said J. J. Griffin with all the right and title which he the said Nathan Whitfield has heretofore held in the same to him the said J. J. Griffin his heirs and assigns forever upon trust nevertheless that he the said J. J. Griffin at the request of either of the parties shall as soon as conveniently he can after such notice advertise the time & place of sale of the above described property at least ten days previous to such sale the terms being for cash paid down and out of the monies raised thereon first pay all reasonable costs and charges attending the full execution hereof and next satisfy the aforesaid debts or as much of them as the amount of sale will do & if o surplus money thereafter remain he the said Griffin shall pay over the same to him the said Nathan Whitfield or to his order in writing when of the parties have accounts set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year first before written
