

This Indenture

made this 15th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two between Robert Murrell of the first part William A Jones of the second part and Joseph T. Claud of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Minnebeth that whereas the said Robert Murrell is justly indebted to the said Joseph T. Claud the sum of three hundred and eighty two dollars lawful money of Virginia and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said William A Jones before the signing and sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Robert Murrell hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William A Jones his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit: One tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton containing one hundred acres be the same more or less and adjoining the land of Benjamin Elds Nathan A. Thomas and others it being the same on which the said Murrell resides and also one yoke of Oxen & 12 head of cattle with their future increase and stock of hogs of every description. To have and to hold to the said land and other property herein mentioned unto him the said William A Jones his heirs and assigns forever. Upon trust nevertheless and upon the express condition that if the said Robert Murrell should fail to pay and settle the above named sum of three hundred dollars on or before the 25 day of December next ensuing then the said William A Jones his heirs, admors, or assigns as the trustee to the said Jones at the request of the said Joseph T. Claud his heirs, admors, or assigns for whose benefit this is intended shall after first advertising the time and place of sale at least ten days previous thereto at some public place or place in the neighbourhood proceed to sell the said land and other property herein before mentioned to the highest bidder for ready money and out of the moneys arising out of the sale of the said land and other property in the first place pay and settle all reasonable cost attending such sale and then the above named sum of three hundred dollars with interest thereon and the remainder of the moneys arising from such sale if any to be paid to the said Robert Murrell or his order and the said William A Jones covenant and agrees with the other parties to this indenture to faithfully discharge the duties vested in him as trustee of the said Murrell whereof the before named parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and date first above written.
