Witnesseth that the said Wm. M. Wells stands justly indebted to the said Jesse Parker in the sum of one hundred & seventy two dollars & thirty eight cents due by bond bearing date the 19th day of June one thousand eight hundred and forty two. Now the said Wells being willing & desirous to secure the said Jesse Parker in the sum of one hundred & seventy two dollars and so and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid, (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) hath bargained, sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Williams a certain tract or parcel of land which the said Wells now occupies containing one hundred and five acres more or less bounded by the lands of Henry Gardner, David William O. Lawrence and others to the said Seth D. Williams in Trust. Now the condition of the above obligation is such that should the said William M. Wells fail to pay to the said Jesse Parker the above sum of one hundred & seventy two dollars then the said Seth D. Williams after being duly notified by the said Parker and advertising in the neighborhood for 15 days before hand shall proceed to sell at public auction for cash the above mentioned tract or parcel of land and after satisfying the trust and all reasonable expenses, the balance if any, to be paid to the said William M. Wells or his heirs, assigns under our hands and seals this 15th day of June 1862.
