This Indenture made and entered into this 10th day of October in the year of our Lord 1862 between Henry Joppe Augustus Pope and Simon Pope all of them of the County of Southampton State of Virginia with respect that he the said Henry Joppe in order to secure to the said Simon Pope the payment of one hundred sixty nine dollars & ninety three cents with interest thereon from October 1862 till paid the same being justly due the said Simon Pope and in consideration of the further sum of one dollar paid to the said Henry Joppe by the said Augustus Pope at or before the making & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Simon hath bargained & sold by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Augustus Pope one negro man slave named Nat all the right title interest & estate which he the said Henry Joppe had in & to the tract of land formerly owned by John Joppe on which Presilla Joppe widow & relict of the said John Joppe do now live and disposed to contain acres of land be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of the following named persons to wit Thomas Newson James Monroe Mista Pops William & Mildred & Martine Monroe and the division and divisions remainder & remainders unto & profits of the said interest in the said land whatsoever to have & to hold

the said interest in both to wit the negro man slave Nat. & the above described land with the appurtenances unto the said Augustus Pope his heirs & assigns upon trust nevertheless that he the said Augustus Pope at the request of either party shall as soon as conveniently he can after having advertised the same & placed ten days previous sell the said negro man slave named Nat. as well as the above described interest in the said land back and out of the moneys raised by such sale pay all reasonable costs & charges incurred hereby & red satisfy the aforesaid debt & interest which may have accrued thereon and if a surplus money remain pay the same to the said Henry Joppe or to his order his heirs assigns, Exors or assigns in witness whereof the parties herein have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year before written
