This Instrument made and entered into this 10th day of October in the year of our Lord 1862 between Henry Lyman Augustin Pope and Simon Pope all of them of the County of Southampton State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Henry Joiner in order to secure to the said Simon Pope the payment of one hundred sixty nine dollars & ninety three cents with Int. thereon from October 1862 till paid the same being justly due the said Simon Pope and in consideration of the sum of one dollar paid to the said Henry Joiner by the said Augustin Pope at or before the making & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the said Joiner hath bargained sold & by these presents doth grant, bargain & sell unto the said Augustin Pope one negro man slave named Nat all the right title interest & estate which the said Henry Joiner has in the tract of land formerly owned by John Joiner on which Priscilla Joiner widow & relist of the said John Joiner do now live and supposed to contain acres of land the same more or less and bounded by the lands of the following named persons to wit Thomas Newson James Horrocks Masta Pope William Wilson & Hartwell Horrell and the various and reversions, remainders & remainders unto & profits of the said interest in the said land whatsoever to have & to hold the said interest in both to wit the negro man slave Nat. of the above described land with the appurtenances unto the said Augustin Pope his heirs & successors upon trust, nevertheless that the said Augustin Pope at the request of either party shall as soon as conveniently he can after having advertised the time & place to day previous sell the said negro man slave Nat as well as the above described interest in the land for cash and out of the monies raised by such sale pay all reasonable costs & charges incurred thereby to meet & satisfy the aforesaid debt & interest which may have accrued thereon and if a surplus money remain pay the same to the said Henry Joiner Joiner at his order his heirs executors or assigns in农业科技 when of the parties herein have huncunis set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year before written
