 Hawkins Pond and Eliza C his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars
 to them in hand paid by the said Archer P. Pond at a before the entering & delivery of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have granted bargained sold and conveyed unto
 presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Archer P. Pond his heirs & assigns
 adm^r a p^{er}ign, one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the said County
 of Southampton, containing by estimation Four hundred & Eighty one and a half acres be the
 same more or less, and bounded as follows; On the West by the lands of Alfred J. Biddle on
 the South ^{part} by the lands of Bob Roberts Dec^d and Isaac White, on the South by the lands of
 Wyatt Hancock (by right of his wife) and Robinson Holt, on the East by the lands of Stephen
 Andrews & Jesse & Thomas Hart, and on the north by Seacoak Swamp and well known from any
 guess as said Hawkins Ponds residence and recently as the residence of said Archer P. Pond
 with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining
