made this twenty ninth day of July in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty two between Isaac Bailey (Jr.) of the first part Jordan Coker Sr of the second part and Alfred J. Brittle of the third part. in witness whereof the said Isaac Bailey is justly indebted to the said Alfred J. Brittle in the sum of fourteen dollars & fifty cents to be paid on the first day of October next as by above being due first day of October 1842. more plainly appears which debt with the legal interest thereon accruing as well as all other debt that may become due and owing from the said Isaac Bailey either by contract or transfer of debt appears to the said Alfred J. Brittle the said Isaac Bailey is willing and desirous to discharge. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Isaac Bailey in hand paid by the said Jordan Coker Sr and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Isaac Bailey hath bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell and confirm to the said Jordan Coker his heirs and assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia and bounded as followeth by the lands of A. P. Bond Myatt Hancock Alfred J. Brittle and Bob Roberts containing thirty seven & a acres more or less. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto the said Jordan Coker his heirs and assigns for ever upon Trust nevertheless that the said Jordan Coker shall as soon as convenient after being ordered by the said Alfred J. Brittle or he himself may think proper advertise giving ten days notice and proceeds to sell the said tract or parcel of land to the highest bidder for cash current money of Virginia and out of the money arising from the sale in the first place pay and satisfy all reasonable charges attending the sale and then the debt above mentioned and the residue of the money arising from the sale as aforesaid to the said Isaac Bailey his executor admr or assigns or to such person or persons as he by writing under his hand shall appoint. The condition of the above indenture is such that if the said Isaac Bailey pay & satisfy all the above named
