Curley at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged here bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said John M. Curley his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton supposed to contain fifty acres be the same more or less and adjoining the land of Benjamin Cobb M. Cobb & others together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises herein before mentioned unto the said John M. Curley his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said John M. Curley his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lucy Cobb for herself & her heirs solemnly warrant and defend the right and title in and to the above mentioned land and premises against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons claiming by or through her unto the aforesaid John M.
