This Indenture made the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October 1842 between Albert Mc Nicholson of the one part John M Gurley of the second part and Joseph A Barham of the third part all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Albert Mc Nicholson in order to secure the following debts a bond is executed to Joe A Barham for about fifteen dollars due Jan'y 1/1/1841. one other bond executed by the same to the same due Jan'y 1/1/1842 for the sum of fifty three dollars 45<sup>cts</sup>. One other bond executed by the same to the same dated October 31/1842 and payable Jan'y 1/1/1843 for the sum of two hundred and thirty dollars. And in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by the said John M Gurley at a before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. At the said Albert Mc Nicholson hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said John M Gurley all rights and title I have in and to the following slaves Negro man Isaac, Moses by Washington and girl Rebecca also my interest in all the slaves now held as slaves by Mrs Ann Brown which devolved to her by her intermarriage with my deceased father Robert Nicholson. And also all my right title and interest in the slaves and now held by the aforesaid Ann Brown. Doth also and doth hold the said slaves and land herein before mentioned to be hereby granted with them and every of their appurtenances unto the said John M Gurley his heirs executors adms and assigns forever Upon Trust nevertheless that the said John M Gurley shall as soon as required by either of the parties hereto advertise the property hereby conveyed at three or more public places within County giving at least twenty days notice of the time and place of sale proceed to sell to the highest bidder at public auction the aforesaid property and out of the monies arising from such sale in the first place to pay and satisfy all reasonable charges attending such sale and then the debt above mentioned and the residue if any remain pay to the aforesaid Albert Mc Nicholson his executors, adms or assigns or to such person or persons as he by his writing shall appoint to receive the same. Witnesseth that whereas the said Robert Murrell has become bound unto the said Joseph Cland in one written obligation for three hundred dollars bearing date on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 1842 which said debt a deed in trust has been made to secure but in order to more effectually to secure the same the said Robert Murrell for and in consideration of the above sum of three hundred dollars as also one dollar in hand paid him by the said John M Gurley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robert Murrell he the said Murrell hath granted bargained and sold &
