The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Robert Pettlow is one of the distributors of the estate of Ann Pettlow deceased and the said Thomas J. Pettlow is administrator of said Ann Pettlow and the said Thomas J. Pettlow hath this day paid to the said Robert Pettlow as distributor aforesaid the sum of four thousand two hundred and eighty five dollars out of the estate of said Ann Pettlow.
