Know all men by these presents that we Robert S Pettow, Alfred Riecke & James D Bryant are held and firmly bound unto Thomas J Pettow administrator of Ann Pettow in the sum of eight thousand dollars to which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs and administrators jointly and severally, firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and date this twenty first day of November one thousand eight hundred and forty two.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Robert Pettow is one of the distributees of the estate of Ann Pettow dec^d and the said Thomas J Pettow is administrator of said Ann Pettow and the said Thomas Pettow hath this day paid to the said Robert Pettow as distributee aforesaid the sum of four thousand two hundred and eighty five dollars out of the ^{estate} of said Ann Pettow. Now if the said Robert S Pettow shall well and truly refund due proportion of any debts & demands which may hereafter arise against the said estate and the costs attending the recovery of such debts then the said obligation to be void else to remain in full force

Now if the said Robert Pettow guardian as aforesaid shall well and truly refund due proportion of any debts & demands which may hereafter arise against the said estate and the costs attending the recovery of such debts then the said obligation to be void, else to remain in full force
