This Indenture made and entered into this 10th day of June 1842 between Rob-
 ert A. Holson and Elizabeth H. his wife of the one part and John Booth of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Robert A. Holson and Elizabeth H. his wife for and in consideration
 of the sum of eleven hundred & ninety one dollars to them in hand paid by the said Booth
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given, granted, bargained & sold by these
 presents, de jure, grant, bargain sell, and convey unto him the said Booth, his heirs & assigns & from
 out certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and known by the
 Boundary Tract, belonging heretofore to Edmund Turner, the father of the said Elizabeth H. Containing
 about 397 acres be the same more or less. To have and to hold the said bargained & sold
 tract of land and all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
 wise appertaining unto him the said Booth, his heirs assigns & forever and the said Robert A. Holson
 and Elizabeth H. his wife for themselves, their heirs, execs. and admors. hereby covenant with said Booth
 that they will forever warrant and defend unto the said Booth, his heirs assigns & forever the
 right and title to said tract of land with its appurtenances & aforesaid, free from the claim of
 themselves, their heirs execs. and admors. and all and every other person whatever.
