This deed of Trust between Joshua Ogner and wife of the first part Currs Bowers of the second  
part and James Holmes of the third part, was proved by the oaths of William Varon of the second  
Lawrence Moe of the witnesses thereto & having been before proved in the Clarks Office the 21<sup>st</sup> of Nov  
ber 1842 by the oath of Benj. Griffin another witness thereto &c. Together with the certificate of the  
private examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record

This Indenture

made and entered into this 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1842 between Robt.  
A. Holson and Elizabeth H. his wife of the one part and John Booth of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said Robert A. Holson and Elizabeth H. his wife for and in consideration  
of the sum of eleven hundred & ninety one dollars to them in hand paid by the said Booth  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given, granted, bargained & sold by these  
present, de jure, grant, bargain sell, and convey unto him the said Booth, his heirs & assigns &c. from  
and certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and known by the  
Boatbay Tract, belonging heretofore to Edmund Turner, the father of the said Elizabeth H. Containing  
about 397 acres be the same more or less. To have and to hold the said bargained & sold  
tract of land and all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any  
wise appertaining unto him the said Booth, his heirs assigns &c. forever and the said Robert A. Holson  
and Elizabeth H. his wife for themselves, their heirs, execs. and admors. hereby covenant with said Booth  
that they will ferre warrants and defend unto the said Booth, his heirs assigns &c. forever the  
right and title to said tract of land with its appurtenances &c. aforesaid, free from the claim of  
themselves, their heirs execs. and admors. and all and every other person whatever.
