This Indenture made and entered into on this 6th day of August 1842 by and between Mills
 Morrell and Matilda Morrell his wife also Henry Kindred Trustees of the one part and Exum Bryant
 of the other part all of whom reside in the County of Southampton this indenture witnesseth that
 they the said Mills Morrell his wife Matilda and Henry Kindred who holds the right in Trust
 have for and in consideration of the sum of ninety two dollars in hand paid by the above named
 Exum Bryant of them the said Mills Morrell his wife Matilda & Henry Kindred Trustees & by them
 immediately paid over to William Morrell for whose benefit the said Kindred holds title in Trust to
 the lands hereby sold & hereafter described, they the said Mills Morrell & wife Matilda & Henry
 Kindred have bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the above
 named Exum Bryant his heirs and assigns the following lot or parcel of land containing Twenty three
 acres by late survey and bounded by the lands of the following named persons to wit: Mills Morrell the above
 named Mills Morrell, Augustin Pope & the above named Exum Bryant, the said lands lying and being
 in the County of Southampton & a part of the land conveyed to the above named Henry Kindred in Trust to
 secure a debt due to William Morrell as aforesaid. To have and to hold the said lot and parcel of land
 with all the right title interest & estate therein to him the said Exum Bryant his heirs and assigns
 forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Exum Bryant his heirs & assigns forever
 free from the claim of either him the said Mills Morrell, Matilda Morrell his wife & also free from
 the claim of him the above named Henry Kindred Trustees and they the said Mills Morrell and
 Matilda his wife for themselves do hereby warrant and forever defend the title in fee simple of in & to the
 said Twenty three acres of land to him the said Exum Bryant his heirs & assigns forever against
 the claim or lawful demand of all & every person or persons whomsoever & he the said Henry Kindred
 doth hereby warrant and defend the title of & in the said Twenty three acres of land to him the said
 Exum Bryant against himself his heirs and assigns forever in witness whereof they the said Mills
 Morrell his wife Matilda Morrell and Henry Kindred have hereunto set their hands and affixed their
 seals the day and year herein first before written
