This Indenture made and entered into on this 29th day of September 1842,
by and between Benjamin Burns and Sally Burns his wife of the one part and Jacob Barnes of
the other part each of whom resides in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia.
This Indenture witnesseth that in the said Benjamin Burns & Sally Burns his wife having
consideration of the sum of sixteen hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Jacob
Barnes at the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
have bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said
Jacob Barnes one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of South-
ampton and bounded abutting to west beginning at the publick bridge over the river of the northeast
branch or prong of said Burn's Mill pond from thence down said river or prong to the river
the Cypress Swamp in said Millpond thence down said swamp passing said mill to William Cutts
line thence along said Cutts line to except a straight space or new road thence a long said straight
or new road to its intersection with the old former road thence nearly north across a line
of marked trees to the Chappel Road so called thence a long said Chappel Road to the said bridge
the beginning which boundary lines is supposed to contain or inclose a bout two hundred and
twenty five acres of land, the mattereth not whether more or less all of which lands within said
boundaries together with a Water grist mill attached thereto as well as all other improvements and
appurtenances to the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Jacob Barnes
to his heirs and assigns forever to have and to hold the said land and every part and parcel thereof
with the appurtenances as aforesaid to him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever free
from the claim of them the said Benjamin Burns and Sally Burns his wife their heirs and assigns
and also free from the claim of any and every person or persons whomsoever, will and doth therefore
warrant and defend the title of the said land and premises against the claims and claims of all
and every person and persons whomsoever in witness whereof the said Benjamin Burns and Sally Burns
have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year herein first before written
