This Indenture made this the 21st day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty two between Jeremiah Chappel of the first part, Thomas J Britton - trustee of the second part and Thomas Preston of the third part all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia - witnesseth that whereas the said Jeremiah Chappel stands justly indebted to Thomas Preston in the sum of three hundred & fifty dollars due by bond bearing date the 17th day of July eighteen hundred & thirty nine also one other bond for the further sum of three hundred dollars bearing date the 5th day of August eighteen hundred & forty signed Jeremiah Chappel, Matthew Hills & James Vick - which debt to the said Jeremiah Chappel stands more fully to secure and pay unto the said Thomas Preston in consideration thereof in further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him the said Jeremiah Chappel in hand paid by the said Thomas J Britton before the signing sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Jeremiah Chappel doth hereby acknowledge he the said Jeremiah Chappel owes for himself his heirs & assigns give grant bargains sell & deliver by these presents hath given granted bargained & delivered and by these presents hath given grants bargained & sold & delivered to said Thomas J Britton his heirs & assigns forever for purposes herein after mentioned. One certain tract or parcel of land and one half of a water grist mill & mill seat attached to the said land, lying on the south side of Black Creek swamp being bounded by said swamp up to John D Johnson's land up said Johnson's line to Matthew Williams line thence out to the Rudey pond branch down said branch to James Vick's land - down Vick's line to the Quaker road bounded by the road to Tidus Draper's line thence down said Draper's line to Black Creek swamp - containing by estimation one hundred & eighty six & half acres. To have and to hold the above tract of land & half of the mill & mill seat of my part thereof free and clear from all lawful claims or incumbrances of any person or persons whatsoever unto him the said Thomas J Britton his heirs and assigns forever in trust nevertheless that the said Thomas J Britton his executors administrators or assigns shall and may at any time when required by Thomas Britton sell the said land and one half the said mill & mill seat for ready money first giving ten days notice of the time & place of sale by public advertisement at the Courthouse door or any other public place near the said land & mill with money arising from the sale thereof to apply to the payment of the aforesaid debts due to the aforesaid Thomas Britton or so much thereof as remains due or unpaid & the interest thereof together with the cost accruing by reason of these presents and to make & execute a deed for the said land & half of the mill & mill seat to the purchaser thereof and the balance of the money if any to pay to the said Jeremiah Chappel his heirs or assigns - In witness whereof we before named have hereunto set our hands & seals the day & year above written
