This Indenture made and entered into this 19th day of November for the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two between Caswell Worrell and Jane Worrell his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Benjamin Pope of the same County & State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Caswell Worrell and Jane Worrell his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and two dollars to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin Pope at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell & confirm unto him the said Benjamin Pope his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by late survey one hundred and fifty one acres be the same more or less adjoining the lands of Hartwell Worrell Sally Duff Sally Pope John Washam & others and being the same tract of land the said Caswell Worrell purchased of William L & John R Rochelle together with all the right title interest claim or demand of in and to the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Benjamin Pope his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Benjamin Pope his heirs and assigns forever and the said Caswell Worrell and Jane his wife for themselves their heirs Executors & administrators doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Benjamin Pope his heirs Executors & assigns that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof the said Caswell Worrell & Jane his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first before written.
