This Indenture made and entered into on this 8 day of January In the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty two between Anthony Harris of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part and Benjamin C Waller of the same County & State of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Anthony Harris for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars current money of the Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin C Waller at or before the sealing or delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, granted, bargained, sold, alienated, enfeoffed and Conformed, and by these presents distinctly bargained, sell, alien, enfeoff and Conform unto him the said Benjamin C Waller his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Lukes Containing by a late survey, Eighty six and two thirds acres to the same now or heretofore being a part of the tract of land whereon said Anthony Harris resided and bounded as follows, to wit Beginning at a red oak standing in said Anthony Harris line a compass
