Now This Indenture witnesseth, that for and in con- sideration of the natural love and affection which Simon Musfer bears to his daughter, Marce- pisa the wife of Jacob Lewis, as well as the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by James M^r Musfer Trustee before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Musfer, has given, granted, sold and conveyed and by these presents doth give, grant, sell and convey unto him the said James M^r Musfer Trustee, his heirs and assigns forever, the following property, Viz: And further he doth give, grant, sell, his heirs, trunks, two mahogany tables, one pine table, one loom & gear, one mahogany side board, one mirror, twelve window chairs, two flay chairs, three pair of andirons, two sets seven pipes and their incense, six sheep with their incense, five head of cattle & their incense, one pair flat iron, one pair of Shovels & tongs, five silver table spoons, twelve earthen plates, eight earthen dishes, one set of china, three coffee pots, one frying pan, two pots & three kettles, one spinning wheel & cards, one cart wheels & gear, one lot of timber, James tools & leather, one coffee mill, one lot of salted pork one gig & harness, six stone gars three stone jugs, one lot of books one lot of Corn & feed &c. & also knives & forks & tacks and other broad things. To have and to hold the said property, to him and his heirs forever. Upon Trust nevertheless, and for the following purposes. That the said Trustee shall hold the said property for the sole and separate use of Marcepsa Lewis wife of Jacob Lewis, and permit her to enjoy the same, free from the claim and demand and control of Jacob Lewis, and to be in no way or manner, subject to any debt or demand which the said Jacob Lewis now owes or which he may hereafter contract, and at the death of the said Mrs Marcepsa Lewis, the said Trustee shall convey the said property, to her children if she has any, and if she should die without a living child then the Trustee shall convey the same to the then living children of Simon Musfer.
