Murfey Trustee, his heirs and assigns forever, the following property, Viz: two feather beds, beds & furniture, two chests, two trunks, two mahogany tables, one pine table, one loom & gear, one mahogany side board, one mirror, twelve window chairs, two flag chairs, three pair of andirons, two bows down pegs and their increase, six sheep with their increase, five head of cattle & their increase, one pair of iron, one pair of shovels & tongs, five silver table spoons, twelve earthen plates, eight earthen dishes, one set of china, three coffee pots, one frying pan, two pots & three kettles, one spinning wheel & cards, one cart wheel & gear, one lot of timber, James tools & leather, one coffee mill, one lot of salted pork one gig & harness, six stone gars three stone jugs, one lot of books one lot of corn & fodder 2 sets knives & forks 6 tacks and three brood trumps. To have and to hold the said property to him and his heirs forever. Upon Trust nevertheless and for the following purposes. That the said Trustee shall hold the said property for the sole <sup>and</sup> separate use of Narcissa Lewis wife of Jacob Lewis.
